Additionally, Chief Hartin reported the Washington Survey and Rating Bureau (WSRB) completed their evaluation of the district's fire protection capabilities. The Protection Class (PC) for inside town limits improved from a Protection Class 5 to Protection Class 4. County areas within five road miles of a responding fire station and having a standard fire hydrant distribution and water supply have improved from Protection Class 7 to Protection Class 6, effective May 1, 2016.

Chief Hartin stated, "He and Firefighter Dillon Rogers are scheduled to meet with the (WSRB) evaluator in February".

Finance Officer's Report

Office Manager Kim Harpe presented the Monthly Budget Position as of January 14, 2016 to the Board. She reported the Maintenance and Operations budget was 7.5% expended and the Capital budget was .4% expended.
