## RESOLUTION NO. 86-02

A resolution of the Board of Fire Commissioners of Island County Fire Protection District No. 5, providing for the submission to the qualified electors of the fire district at a Special Election to be held therein, in conjunction with the primary election on September 16, 1986, of the proposition which would authorize lifting the 106% lid law for Island County Fire Protection District No. 5, which will authorize the district to increase its regular property tax levy up to \$1.00 per thousand dollars of assessed value pursuant to RCW 84.55.050.

WHEREAS, IN THE JUDGEMENT OF THE BOARD OF FIRE COMMISSIONERS, it is essential and necessary for the protection of public health, life, and property, that necessary equipment and apparatus be acquired and public services be provided to adequately meet the safety needs of the district's community; and,

WHEREAS, the cost increases of operation and the need for advanced training ie: cost has exceeded revenue, because of restrictions imposed by RCW 84.55.010;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Fire Commissioners of Island County Fire Protection District No. 5 submit a proposal to the qualified electors of said district requesting authorization to restore the \$1.00 per thousand of assessed valuation, which is authorized under RCW 84.55.050.
