WHEREAS, RCW 42.14.100 provides that the Board of commissioners has the power and duty to manage and conduct the business affairs of the district and to adopt reasonable rules to govern the district and to perform its functions.

WHEREAS, to effectively engage in risk management and to reduce the areas of liability exposure, the Board of Fire Commissioners, must require that all current and future personnel of the district operate within the standards established by the Board.

WHEREAS, the insurance companies that write fire protection district insurance policies require or recommend, in various areas of operation, that districts establish and enforce written policies and procedures.


WHEREAS, the establishment, maintenance and enforcement of proper policies and procedures is of primary importance to the successful operation of the district.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED, that effective immediately, the Board hereby formally adopts the document entitled "Central Whidbey Fire & Rescue's Employee Handbook", PROVIDED that they hereby reserve the right to amend, change and repeal any adopted policies and procedures and the disclaimer of the creation of contract rights.
