LIMIT FACTOR INCREASE)
CONCERNING 2001 ANNUAL BUDGET)**

RESOLUTION # 00-04

WHEREAS the population of Central Whidbey Island Fire and Rescue is less than 10,000 people; and

WHEREAS RCW 84.55.010 and RCW 84.55.020 allows jurisdictions to levy up to 106% by a simple majority vote of the Fire Commissioners; and

WHEREAS Central Whidbey Island Fire and Rescue (Island County Fire Protection District 5) has met and considered its budget for the calendar year 2001; and

WHEREAS Central Whidbey Island Fire and Rescue in the course of considering the budget for 2001, has reviewed all sources of revenue and examined all anticipated expenses and obligations; and

WHEREAS Central Whidbey Island Fire and Rescue has determined that, due to continued district construction projects, additional equipment purchases and personnel considerations for 2001, there is a substantial need to increase the regular property tax limit factor of 2.61% to a rate equaling 3.39% above the IPD in addition to any new construction values; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE RESOLVED, Central Whidbey Island Fire and Rescue of Island County that the limit factor for the regular levy for the calendar year 2001 shall be 106% of the highest amount of regular taxes that could have been lawfully levied in this taxing district.
