New Business

Chief Helm led the discussion on the termination letter sent from Mary Engle of Island County Planning Dept. to terminate the Inter-Local Agreement between Island County and Central Whidbey Island Fire and Rescue for fire inspections to Central Whidbey business and residents. At this point, since the county no longer employs an inspector, we will not be signing the termination letter.

Chief Helm discussed the hiring of one firefighter that will be starting April 1, 2024 and the discussion of the hiring of future firefighters for the year.

New Business

The board entered into an Executive Session at 5:40 pm for 15 minutes to review personnel matters in accordance with RCW 42.30.110(1)(f).

RCW <u>42.30.110(1)(f)</u> To evaluate the qualifications of an applicant for public employment or to review the performance of a public employee. However, subject to RCW 42.30.140(4), discussion by a governing body of salaries, wages, and other conditions of employment to be generally applied within the agency shall occur in a meeting open to the public, and when a governing body elects to take final action hiring, setting the salary of an individual employee or class of employees, or discharging or disciplining an employee, that action shall be taken in a meeting open to the public;

The following except from the Central Whidbey Island Fire & Rescue Board of Fire Commissioners Policy Manual explains the process used for an executive session:

An executive session is a portion of a meeting of the Board of Fire Commissioners that is closed, or limited to members of the Board and other people whose presence is necessary to conduct the business at hand. The Board's use of an executive session is limited to a narrow set of specific circumstances. In order to qualify for an executive section its purpose must meet one of the provisions of RCW 42.30.

In convening an Executive Session, the Chairperson announces:

- That the Board is going into executive session
- The statutory reason for the Executive session
- That the public is excluded and that they should leave the room
- The time that the Executive session will be concluded (and the public may reenter the room)
- If Board action is expected following the Executive Session

An Executive Session may be extended to a stated later time by announcement of the presiding officer or his/her designee to those waiting outside the meeting room to reenter at its conclusion. Under no circumstance shall the Board ever take any action during an executive session; Board action may only occur during its meetings open to the public.

The board came out of Executive Session ended at 5:55 pm with no decision being made.
